



How Much Would Pet Parents Spend For Their Best Friends?







Lemonade commissioned a survey of 501 dog owners and 501 cat owners to find out. Here's what we learned.




Most Common Dog Diseases and Costs




Average Monthly Cost for Diseases

ByDog Breed






Most Common Cat Diseases and Costs

How Much Are Pet Owners Willing to Spend on Their Pets?

Dog and cat owners would spend an average of \$1,907 per year (roughly 4% of their annual income) to give their furry friends a high quality life.



Dog owners were willing to spend \$2,075 annually to give their dog a quality life.

By dog breed:

Cat owners were willing to spend \$1,746 annually to give their cat a quality life.

Of pet owners, Gen Zers were willing to spend 68% (\$2,293) more than baby boomers (\$1,367) to give their pet a high-quality life.




How much are you willing to spend to give your pet a high-quality life?

By Parental Status




How Much Pet Owners Spend on Their Pets vs. Family Members

On average, dog and cat owners would spend \$6,060 to save their pet in a life-or-death situation.












How Much Pet Owners Would Spend to Save Their Pet

Russian Blue owners were willing to spend the most to save their cat in a life-or-death situation (\$18,226)


Dog and cat owners were willing to spend \$3,525 on new treatments and medicines to extend a pet's lifespan.




ThinkingAboutYour Pet's Future

Nearly 42% of dog and cat owners weren't confident they could afford life-saving treatments for their pets.


Percentage of Pet Owners with a Pet Emergency Fund or Pet Savings Account
